*From the pen  
of Pastor Mark*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Easter! On the weekend leading up to Holy Week we welcomed a sea of joyous young children from our community to our Easter Egg Hunt, then raised our palms in procession on Palm Sunday. On Maundy Thursday we shared the Meal and then slowly stripped the altar, preparing for a moving Good Friday service of shadows and the seven last words of Christ. Our Vigil on Saturday went from darkness to Easter light and celebration, which came with full fanfare to our risen Lord on Easter morning. It was a great Holy Week of deeply remembering and honoring our Lord in worship. Thanks to everyone who so faithfully played a part both out front and behind the scenes. We served as a great team together and it was an honor to be your pastor in the midst of this sacred time.

As I write this we prepare for several upcoming memorial services at Holy Trinity. To be honest, it's not the hope and dream of a pastor to have funerals and memorials in the season of Easter, especially right after Holy Week and the culmination of Easter Sunday. In a way it feels like a Good Friday all over again. In a way it is. Our services at Holy Trinity in these times acknowledge death, loss, and pain. We need that acknowledgement, and in the public setting of worship there is place and space to grieve. It is not unlike our emotions of Good Friday.

At the same time we know where the path of Holy Week leads, and the Good News that ends with Easter alleluias. Our memorial services and funerals also acknowledge the Easter Good News. This is why sometimes in the services, we might have both tears and laughter, sniffles and smiles. It is why I've often said that in memorial services we honor the reality that there has been an end; that things will not be the same and that there is true loss. At the same time, our faith reminds us it is an end and not the end. Even in the midst of our grief, yet we can have real peace and perhaps even a spark of joy because of the Easter Good News of life everlasting. So maybe in some ways, perhaps the season of Easter is actually a beautiful time to have memorials and funerals at Holy Trinity.

The season of Easter this year spans the month of May and goes just into June as well. How will we take the Good News of the risen Lord with us on our journey this month? Will there be other unexpected "Good Fridays" ahead? Unexpected times of darkness, shadow, dread, and death? Even if so, we are witnesses not only to Good Friday but also to the resurrection. We are Easter people! We have come to the table. We have tasted and seen that the Lord is good (Psalm 34:8). We are witnesses both to the empty tomb and to the risen Lord on Easter. We are also witnesses to the risen Lord in our lives. This is Good News of great joy we can take with us each day. We can take it out into the world. We can take it to the bank, so to speak, for it is true. And yes, we can take it to the grave. No matter what may come, we take the Good News of the resurrection with us, knowing that nothing can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:31-39).

So this May, may our worship, our lives, our voices, and our hearts be shouts of alleluia, no matter what may come. For we are Easter people, and our Lord is risen!

Holy Week and Easter services were the most beautiful and meaningful experiences I have ever witnessed. Pastor Mark's love and compassion was extremely evident to all present and online. Thank you for the enormous effort to all that participated and supported the services.

Holy Trinity is just about back to normal as far as the COVID restrictions go. The talk of another variant is being closely monitored but appears not to be of major concern. All statistics have shown decreasing numbers these last few months. Hopefully, it stays that way. I realize many of our friends have not returned to in-person worship but are with us and God via our online service. We miss and love you all and pray that you may be able to join us here on campus.

Please join me in welcoming our new Youth Director, Sal Espino. He brings not only much experience but a most energetic personality. Sal jumped in whole-heartedly and is an inspiration to all. Also, Sharon Foran is the new Children and VBS Coordinator and we are happy to have her in that role.

### *The Power of Prayer*

I also want to share some personal examples of the power of prayer. Almost 2 years ago Pat's sister, Peggy was put into the hospital with profoundly serious colon issues as if the rheumatoid arthritis she suffered from wasn't enough. This was during the pandemic, and she required an ileostomy and became septic as well. Peggy's doctor notified the family that she would probably not survive the night and the immediate family was not allowed to visit due to COVID. Prayers had been requested from Day 1 and everyone prayed. Peggy survived that night and was on her way to recovery and home after many weeks.

My sister, Lynn suffered with nausea for 1 ½ years at about the same time. She couldn't keep anything down. She had every test known to man, and the doctors could not come up with a diagnosis. Lynn also suffers with rheumatoid arthritis. Her weight dropped from 185 to 110. Doctors thought she was crazy. This also was during the pandemic and family couldn't visit. Prayers again were said daily. Then, without any cure for the nausea, Lynn slowly became coherent and started eating again keeping both her meals and medications down. Recovery continued slowly. After many weeks of rehab, she came home and is now fully recovered.

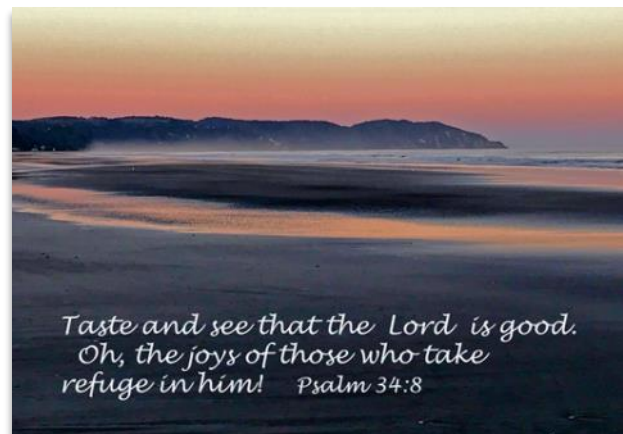

## ***A Message from Your Stewardship Ministry Team:***

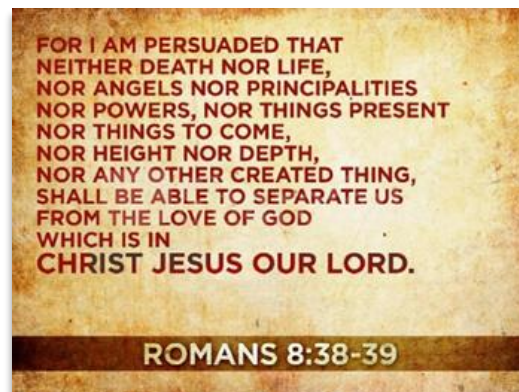

### BOT Scholarship

Holy Trinity men's group, Bible on Tap, offers a \$500 annual scholarship to a male high school senior and member of Holy Trinity who intends to pursue a secondary education at a college or technical school.

The successful candidate will receive the scholarship in August prior to beginning his first year of college or technical school. The \$500 scholarship will renew for up to three years thereafter, contingent upon the student's successful completion of the previous academic year and continued full-time enrollment in a degree program.

Interviews will be conducted in May. **Applications must be received in the church office no later than May 1.** Please address the application to "Bible on Tap, Attention Scholarship Committee." The application should contain a summary of the candidate's academic record, high school activities, community activities, and involvement at Holy Trinity.

An application is available in the church office and on the church website under forms.

### WELCA Scholarship

Holy Trinity's Women of the ELCA organization will again offer an educational scholarship of \$1,000. It is the intent of this organization to encourage women of all ages to expand their current talents as a Christian and perhaps carry those and newly-learned talents into an area that will enable her to help others know God too.

To be eligible you must be a female member of Holy Trinity who intends to pursue college or technical studies and have graduated from high school. Candidates should write a short one-page essay about their goals, financial need and objectives and include a copy of their most recent transcript. **Application due date is Monday, June 6.**

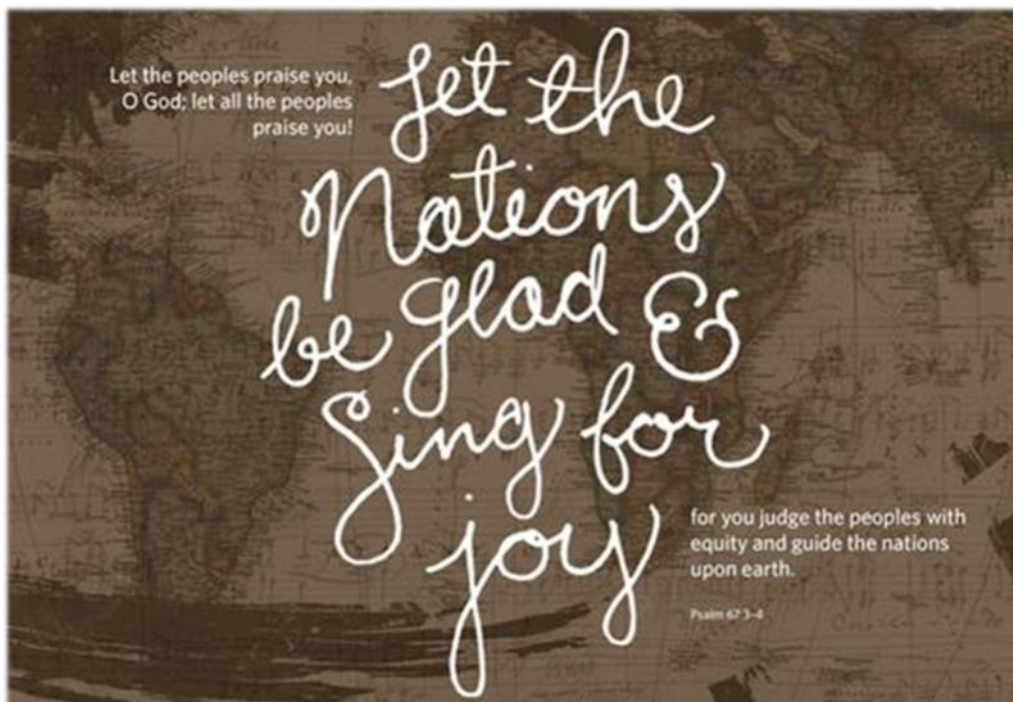
