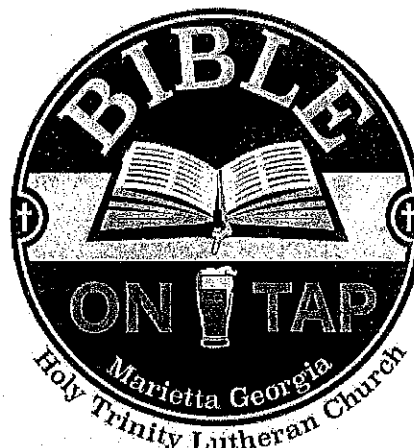


Bible on Tap Men's Ministry Holy Trinity Lutheran Church 2020 Annual Report

OVERVIEW:

BOT is a self-funded Men's Ministry group which was founded in 2012. Originally a fellowship group meeting the second Saturday of each month, the group transitioned in 2015 to focusing on service projects and fellowship. In 2016 the group added a second monthly meeting on the fourth Tuesday evening of each month. BOT currently has 80 + men on our mailing list.

ACTIVITIES and ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

- Provided breakfast for 40 men and dinner for 60 men at the Men's Extension in Marietta 4 times each in 2020, an increase of 100% over 2019. Also, donated many clothing and linen items for the men rehabilitating there.
- Donated \$1000 to American Legion Post 29 for the Veterans 5K race which supports many worthwhile veteran's charities. Many BOT members are veterans.
- Donated \$575 to purchase gift cards for foster children graduating high school in Cobb County.
- Workday to wash and wax the church bus, we also provide the insurance and maintenance for the bus, as we have every year since its purchase in 2015.
- Helped long time HT members with yard maintenance 2 times in 2020, including the rental of refuse dumpster for its removal. BOT also assisted in moving 1 member into a new home. These efforts were approximately 100-man hours of labor.
- Donated \$500 to the Atlanta Hunger Walk
- COVID prevented BOT from doing our annual Habitat volunteering, so we were a Silver Sponsor of Un-taste of Habitat with donation of \$500
- Picked up 2 pallets of food from Atlanta Food Bank twice during last quarter and delivered them to HT, for the Blessings in a Backpack program.
- Donated \$250 to youth for Valentine Dinner fundraiser.

- Delivered more than 300 Advent bags to Holy Trinity members at their homes for Christmas. The men drove 800 miles delivering this wonderful gift.
- Held 2 fundraisers for our 4-year \$500 a year scholarship program raising \$5500 toward our goal to make the program self-sustaining.
- Awarded \$500 each to 2 fine young HT men as Men's' Ministry scholarship recipients.
- Moved furniture out of Sunday School rooms with 3 pick up trucks and delivered to American Thrift donation center
- Repaired Art Davis Memorial Field sign behind the church parking lot
- Created BOT Mission Statement
- Honored fallen BOT member Dave Lovich with a prayer and candle lighting at our Saturday August meeting. Dave loved being a part of BOT!!!
